

2022 Walk in the Word Bible Reading Plan –



To our Metro Family and Friends,

2022 will be our second year Walking in the Word together with the study of daily scriptures. The Lord has brought us this far in our journey (102 years!), strengthening us, enlightening us, and convicting us with His Word. Each month as we topically study the Bible, let us be mindful of our 2022 theme “ReLAUNCH: *Recommit, Release, Refocus.*” As Christians, we need to constantly give ourselves to Christ: Mind, Body, and Spirit. Our journey is not easy, for Christ said that if we follow Him, we would have our own cross to bear for we know the devil is busy and sin is every present. BUT with Bible study we will be equipped to do the work of the Lord and overcome sin and the schemes of the devil. For Christ has defeated them through His Life, Death, and Resurrection!

As we study together, we are all living the Lord’s call for unity and like-mindedness, not because we are all the same, but because we are moving in the will and the way of the Lord *together*. Jeremiah 29:11 says “For I know the plans I have for you,” declares the LORD, “plans to prosper you and not to harm you, plans to give you hope and a future.” By mediating on His Word, we will know His purpose for our lives, as individuals and as a church body. As we mediate on His Word, we will be equipped to spread the Gospel, which is our Great Commission. (Matthew 28:16-20) Through the meditation of His Word, we will gain a deeper relationship with Christ for He is the Word made flesh. (John 1) The Lord wants us to grow and move from youth to Christian maturity, from complacent to actively transformative in our obedience to the Lord and how we demonstrate our love for Him and others. So as we study in unity, let the Word saturate our hearts and minds *to live the Word* in our thoughts, words, and deeds.

During your study time, eliminate distractions and prepare your heart and mind with prayer. Read with expectancy, not just for knowledge, but for change and growth as a Christian. Read a version that allows you to gain a clear understanding of the Word. Pastor Williams, III recommends English Standard Version (ESV), New Revised Standard Version (NRSV), and New King James Version (NKJV).
